NORTH SEATTLE INFANT COOPERATIVE HEALTH RULES

- 1. The infant class adheres to Washington State guidelines for childhood immunizations. An Immunization form must be completed for each infant.
- 2. We request that you not attend when your infant has these symptoms of illness:
 - a. A temperature within the last 24 hours of 100 degrees rectally or 99 orally.
 - b. The first 3 days of a cold which is often accompanied by a fever, restlessness, and is the most contagious period.
 - c. Color to the runny nose.
 - d. A rash; earache; sore throat; cough; red, runny or dull eyes; or if he or she is overly tired and cranky.
 - e. If a bacterial infection, must be on antibiotics for 48 hours before returning to class.
 - f. Diarrhea, vomiting, or headache 12 hours prior to school.
 - g. Contagious conditions, such as: chicken pox, lice, pin worms, conjunctivitis.
- 3. Notify the teacher or health and safety person of exposure to a contagious disease.
- 4. Inform class of your infant's food allergies or dietary restrictions and check to make sure they are posted.
- 5. Please report accidents to the teacher and assist the teacher in completing accident forms which must be sent to the college.
- 6. Please do not bring hot beverages into the classroom.
